

# **Garden Railroad Volunteer**

## **Position Summary**

Garden Railroad Volunteers are in charge of preparing and running the San Diego Model Railroad Museum Garden layout including running trains and helping with any scavenger hunt questions. This is a great opportunity for anyone with an interest in history, model trains or gardening and will be under the direction of the Volunteer and Experience Coordinator.

### **Qualifications:**

- All volunteers must be 18 years old and up.
- An interest in garden railroads / model railroads
- Ability to work well and communicate with others; Positive attitude & team player
- Customer Service an interest in interacting with families and museum guests.
- Reliable, dependable, responsible, trustworthy
- Ability to physically walk and stand the majority of each shift. Ability to bend, squat and lift up to 15-20 pounds. Ability to reach trains in various areas of the layout if the trains stall. Note: SDMRM is happy to provide reasonable accommodations for individuals with physical limitations.

### **Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Prep display areas around museum for opening and close
- Clean and maintain the wheels and tracks of the layout and the equipment in preparation for museum guests
- Interact with guests and assist with interactive elements of the garden
- Water and maintain centennial garden railway, plants and structures
- Understand safety policies and actively promote safe practices

## **Training and time Commitment:**

- Garden Railroad Volunteers must train for 5 shifts then must commit to a minimum of 2 shifts per month for a minimum of 6 months.
- Shift Hours: 10am 4pm including breaks. The museum is currently open Tuesday Sunday.

#### Volunteers will receive:

- Free admission to the San Diego Model Railroad Museum
- Discount in the gift shop
- Annual appreciation event
- Earn Free passes to hand out to friends and family: 1 pass for every 25 hours of service with an annual max of 5 passes
- Ability to apply volunteer hours towards a museum membership
